The trees planted will restore the tree canopy destroyed in the May 2022 EF-3 tornado, increase climate resiliency, and beautify the community.

At the same time, additional partners from Huron Pines, Huron Pines AmeriCorps, Otsego Community Foundation and Gaylord Long Term Recovery Group will be planting trees on private property.

ReLeaf Michigan's tree experts will be there to show volunteers how to plant a tree and oversee the event. Please wear closed-toe shoes and bring a shovel, hard rake and gloves if you have them. Event occurs rain or shine (we're a hearty group!). No planting experience necessary. Families are welcome! We hope to see you there!
