The neighborhood was identified as a priority for stormwater management benefits as the new trees will help to intercept rainfall and reduce stormwater runoff.

ReLeaf Michigan's tree experts will be there to show volunteers how to plant a tree and oversee the event. Please wear closed-toe shoes and bring a shovel, hard rake, and gloves if you have them.
